Jeweller to the lost: Barbara Heath



Barbara Heath is one of Queensland's foremost jewellers. Over the past twenty-six years Barbara has developed a distinctive style that has won both national acclaim and international exposure.

Having worked across many forms, Barbara currently focuses upon commissioned jewellery, large-scale architectural commissions for buildings and public spaces and a commercial range which retails in a number of prestigious outlets.

Of major concern to Barbara in her work are the interrelationships between maker, object and wearer. These relationships are of particular relevance to her commissioned work.

Barbara describes her role in creating custom jewellery for her clients as 'jeweller to the lost'. She sees people as being 'lost' before they find their particular jewel, and it is Barbara's intention to help others find themselves through possession of the 'right' item of jewellery.

Barbara has held solo exhibitions in Brisbane, Melbourne, Sydney and Japan. Her work is represented in numerous private and public collections, including in Australia the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery, the Powerhouse Museum and the Queensland Art Gallery. Her work can be purchased through the Gallery Store, where for the past year customers have found her work 'too good to resist'.
